WEDNESDAY: Arrival at Zagreb (D)

Transfer from the airport to hotel. Check-in, afternoon at your leisure. Dinner at the hotel.



THURSDAY : Zagreb (B)

The morning will be reserved for a guided tour of the historic Upper Town, where, among other sites, you will find St. Mark's Church, the Cathedral, the Government Palace and the Lotrscak tower. The rest of the day at your leisure.

FRIDAY: Zagreb ► Plitvice Lakes ► Split (B)

Bus trip to Plitvice, approx. 2.5 hrs.

Consisting of 16 lakes connected through a series of waterfalls, this is Croatia's oldest and most beautiful national park.

Trivia: Plitvice Lakes was a popular shooting location in the 60s for Karl May's Winnetou movies.

Our guests will hike through the park, enjoy a boat ride over the emerald green Kozjak Lake and take the street train back to the entrance. Stay time in park: approx. 3 hrs - walking shoes are essential.



Bus trip to Split, approx. 3 hrs. Check-in your hotel for a free evening.

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SATURDAY: Split ► Makarska (B,L)

Guided tour of Split, a city under UNESCO protection with its historical and cultural monuments -- of special interest is the Diocletian Palace. Transfer to the ship and sailing from the Split harbor as your first lunch is served onboard at 13:00. Sail south along the Dalmatian coast. Enjoy the first swim at one of the beautiful white pebbly beaches on the Makarska Riviera, or those who feel adventurous may prefer to join our rafting excursion on the Cetina River, and rejoin the ship at Makarska harbor in the evening. Overnight in Makarska.



SUNDAY: Makarska ► Island of Mljet (B,L)

Early morning departure from Makarska towards Mljet, with the first stop at the Peljesac peninsula for a refreshing swim. The afternoon is free to enjoy the peaceful Mljet exploring its National Park with a salt lake and an abbey and church lying on an islet.

Overnight on this island, in Polaca or Pomena port.



MONDAY: Island of Mljet ► Dubrovnik (B,L)

After breakfast, the ship departs for Dubrovnik, the highlight point of this cruise. There will be a short stop en route for a quick swim. Upon arrival at Dubrovnik's Gruz harbor in the afternoon, a local guide will await to take you for a sightseeing tour, stopping at the city's main historical sites. You'll have enough free time for a walk on your own along the *Stradun* and city walls - do some shopping and find a fine restaurant. Overnight in the port.



TUESDAY: Dubrovnik ► Sipan or Trstenik (B,L,D)

Morning is free for you to enjoy another stroll around this beautiful city, before sailing at noon towards the Sipan on the island of Sipan or further north to Trstenik on the Peljesac peninsula, depending on the weather and situation in ports. There will be an opportunity for a swim and a visit to a local winery. Tonight is Captain's Dinner, serving grilled fresh local seafood. Overnight in port.

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WEDNESDAY: Sipan or Trstenik ► Korcula (B,L)

After breakfast the ship sets sail for Korcula, the birthplace of Marco Polo. Lunch on board today will be served at anchor in front of Korcula's exclusive Lumbarda village. The vessel will then dock at Korcula harbor for the rest of the day and night. A guided tour is provided; in this old town you can find more legends and tales than anywhere else.

Overnight in Korcula.



THURSDAY: Korcula ► Hvar (B,L)

Sailing early in the morning for the Pakleni Islands for lunch and a swim, just in front of the Hvar harbor. Then Hvar, another old town, with a renaissance cathedral, the oldest community theatre in Europe - founded in 1612, yet very fashionable tourist destination, offering abundant entertainment, shopping and fine restaurants. Guided tour is included.

Overnight in Hvar.



FRIDAY: Hvar ► Bol ► Split (B,L)

Our next stop will be Bol on the island of Brac and a visit to its famous beach Zlatni Rat (the Golden Cape) -- the gravel promontory shifts from side to side as the wind and waves change its shape. Bol is a typical fisherman's town turned into a popular tourist destination. After lunch we will start our journey back to Split, make a stop along the way for another swim, before approaching the Split Riviera and arrival in late afternoon.

Overnight alongside in Split's harbor.



SATURDAY: Split departure (B)

Early breakfast after which it is time to say goodbye to the crew and all your new friends (Breakfast box in case of early flight departure). Transfer to the Split Airport. And we hope to see you again on Croatian Coastal Cruises.

- 1 x half-board + 1 x bed & breakfast with a room in 4* Hotel in Zagreb city center (Hotel Dubrovnik, Hotel Palace or similar)
- 1 x bed & breakfast with a room in a 4* hotel in Split (Hotel President, Art, Radisson or similar)

- Airport transfers (from Airport Zagreb and to Airport Split)
- Touring by air-conditioned motor coach as per itinerary
- Sightseeing: Zagreb, Plitvice, Split, Hvar, Korčula, Dubrovnik
- 7-night cruise and half-board service on one of our "A+" category ships
- Accommodation in air-conditioned double (DBL) cabins in the lower deck

- Extra water: EUR 20 per person per week - includes 1,5 liter per person per day (to be paid on the spot)
- English breakfast supplement: EUR 40 per person, per week - incl. 2 eggs, bacon, tomato and mushrooms, or fruit & yoghurt, or similar. (For continental breakfast, included in the fare, the following is served: coffee, tea, milk, glass of juice, cereal, bread, a variety of spreads - butter, honey, jam, soft cheese; daily additions such as ham and cheese or boiled eggs, frankfurters, salami etc.)
- Wedding renewal package: EUR 100 per couple - includes wedding vows renewal ceremony performed by the Captain, certificate, a bottle of champagne and a memento.
- Two towels per week for personal use will be provided -additional towels can be rented for EUR 3,00 and beach towels for EUR 5 per week.
